

SAFETY RULES FOR BUFFALO CREEK'S CAMP BEAR, DEER, BOAR AND BOBCAT HUNTS

1. No loaded guns until you are in your stand. Unload them before coming down or leaving your stand. **NO EXCEPTIONS!** No reloading or shooting after leaving your designated stand, unless instructed to do so by your guide. The only shooting allowed from the ground is from a ground blind.
2. No leaving your stand to walk around. Other hunters may be in your area. It is dangerous for you and for them and may contaminate your hunting area with your scent. If you interfere with others who are hunting, you will be asked to leave without a refund. Do not look for any animal that you have shot. You are at risk of getting lost. We can find almost any animal if you don't walk around on the tracks. We bring all kills back to the camp for gutting.
3. Do not throw trash around your stand. If you carry it in, bring it back out with you.
4. No drinking while hunting or handling guns. **IF YOU DRINK DON'T TOUCH A GUN!!!! NO DRUNKS WILL BE TOLERATED!!!!** You may be asked to leave. Social drinking is permitted at the end of the day.
5. No illegal drugs allowed on the premises of BUFFALO CREEK GUIDE SERVICE, LLC or used while hunting. You will be asked to leave without a refund if you are found doing drugs. If you have them, leave them in your vehicle.
6. No smoking in the lodge, cabins or vehicles. There are smoking areas outside. Please don't throw your butts on the ground.
7. There is no fall turkey season. Extensive fines and a Wildlife Officer will be notified.
8. Safety harnesses must be worn at all times while in any non-enclosed tree stand unit and can be provided at your request.
9. You are allowed to take 1 animal for each day you book. You may choose between deer, boar, or bobcat (Bear hunters ONLY can have one of these animals be a bear). Only 2 of the deer can be antlered bucks. All animals must be in season. Example: 3 day hunters are allowed to harvest any combination of 3 animals (deer, boar, bobcat and bear) any time during the hunt (Only Bear hunters can harvest bear).
10. Please try not to shoot button bucks to help protect future generations.
11. At this time we are only shooting boar hogs. This helps protect sows that are pregnant or nursing pigs. Wild Hogs have no breeding season. You can request a guide sit with you to help in spotting a boar or help you to judge the size.
12. There is a \$300 find for each animal taken over the limit.
13. There is no limit on coyotes.
14. For ear and eye protection we recommend earplugs and protective eyeglasses.
15. Any left behind items may be returned by the mail with a fee of \$25 plus postage.
16. A helmet must be worn while riding on any ATV.
17. Every shot must be treated as a hit until checked by your guide. All shots taken will be checked by a guide. Do not shoot more than your limit until your guide has verified your shot was a hit or a miss. All wounded animals count towards your limit and is at the discretion of the guides.
18. Button bucks with no bone showing count as antlerless deer.
19. Please keep all valuables locked in your vehicle. **WE ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR STOLEN OR LOST PROPERTY.**

All of these rules are designed to make your hunt a safe and enjoyable one. These rules must be followed! Hunters not following these rules will be reminded for the first offense, but will be asked to leave for the second offense with no refund. If you have any questions please feel free to ask. We will be glad to explain them for you. **RULES AND FINES ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE WITHOUT NOTICE.**

In signing this agreement I agree to follow all regulations and laws of the NC Wildlife Resources Commission and know that any laws broken by me will be turned in to a NC Wildlife Officer for investigation and will be subject to
